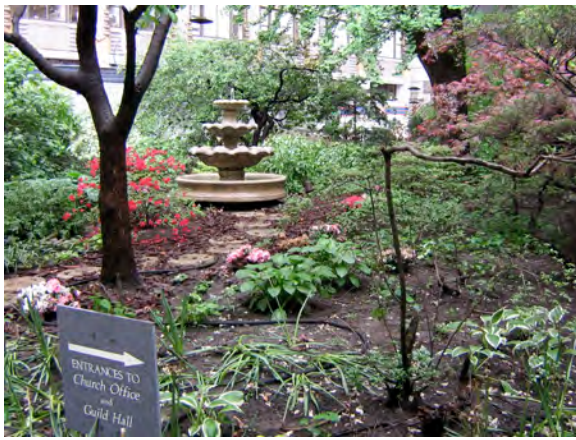

A garden reception follows each performance at this beautiful, historic church, a national landmark.

Set back from East 29th Street, between Fifth and Madison Avenues, behind a restful garden, the Church of the Transfiguration is a rambling structure constructed in stages between 1850 and 1900. The complex is a facsimile of the English countryside in midtown Manhattan and long has been an oasis for harried New Yorkers of all faiths who relax in the garden, pray in the chapel or enjoy free weekday concerts in the main church. Many visitors simply come to admire the warm, richly decorated interior. Through the years, the immense charm of Transfiguration has made it a very popular site for weddings.
